XMAS COCKTAIL CARVING AUCTION

The art of carving cocktail carvings was started many years ago at the California Open Carving Championship as a method of raising money to help fund their show and an in-expensive way for fellow carvers to collect pieces of each other's work.

What is a cocktail carving? As the name suggest it is a small carving that would fit in a cocktail glass.

They may be made of wood, stone, antler, bone, etc. they may use glass eyes

If they have feet, they must be made by the carver.

All species of birds, fish and mammals are acceptable.

Maximum size, the subject must fit in a 4-inch cube, excluding the base. Over the years many carving association have adopted this as a method of raising money to help fund their shows. It is considered good etiquette to donated a cocktail bird to a show or to support a carving association. As we do not conduct an auction at our show, we thought it may be a good idea to have one at our Xmas Party so members would have the opportunity to collect some carvings at a reasonable cost. We have

persuaded some of your instructors and other members to donate some items for the Xmas party.
