The Alberta Wildlife Carving Association will sponsor three purchase awards with additional community based purchase awards to be announced as they become available. AWCA 2014 Purchase Awards are as follows:

- \$1000.00 for the best life-size Songbird, M/F decorative or slick with suitable habitat.
- \$750.00 for the best North American Land Mammal, decorative or slick with suitable habitat.
- \$500 for the best North American Shorebird, decorative or slick (gunning style on a stick acceptable)
- o All entries must be wildlife, no carvings of domesticated animals.
