2014 Basket Weaving- Edmonton Course Description July 8 to 13, 2014

These courses are designed for you to learn and create, while having fun. Three one and a half (1 ½) to two (2) day basket weaving classes will happen over the six (6) days of the school. Using various widths of reed, students will learn basket weaving techniques to create and finish three (3) baskets. They will choose from a variety of natural and hand-dyed reeds, as well as yarn to incorporate their own color choices during the weaving.

Beth Crabb - Weaving Biography

Beth started weaving in 1991 at Crete Nebraska, and learned willow weaving in Sask. She is largely self-taught, and enjoys creating her own designs. Her work in watercolor and clay influence the development of her weavings. Beth enjoys teaching basketry, and sharing her passion for weaving and her love of creating functional works of art. Her baskets have been exhibited in Moose Jaw at Yvette Moore's Gallery, Creative Photographics, the Moose Jaw Museum and Art Gallery, and Lumsden's Letterbox Gallery. In 2007 she was selected as one of three artists to represent Moose Jaw in Ottawa on July 1, to celebrate Moose Jaw as one of the Cultural Capitals of Canada. In 2011, Beth was juried into the Sask. Craft Council. Her weavings are in collections across Canada.

Students will need to bring their own tools, as follows:

Square plastic dishpan-type tub for water, tape measure reed cutters i.e. pruning shears, heavy scissors, awl or nut pick plastic clothespins, pencil, old towel, plastic/vinyl apron Optional: small planer or sharp vegetable peeler Small needle nose pliers and wire cutters-optional Any small, favorite objects they may wish to add on to their projects

Class #1: Feather Basket - 1 ½ Days from July 8 to 9, 2014

This 12" X 12" X 8" high basket has a uniquely woven-on lid, and was originally used for gathering feathers. It is useful now in many other ways, including keeping cats out of your yarn! The weaving to create this basket includes plain weave, twining, your choices to create a decorative section, and fitting the lid to your individual basket. A great addition to any home.



Class #2: Quadro Melon Basket – 1 ½ Days from July 10 to 11, 2014:

Note: Class starts at Noon on July 10*

This weaving starts with a 14" hoop, is about 5" deep, it features two crossing center straps which create four pockets within the basket.

In this basket you will learn how to weave an "X" ear, shape and insert ribs to form your basket's shape, and control the tension of your weaving to fine turn your basket shape. This is a great basket project to explore your colour and texture choices with sea grass and yarn.



Class #3: Lidded Bathroom Buddy - 1 ½ Days from July 12 to 13, 2014:

This basket design allows you to beautifully keep several rolls of bathroom tissue on hand, yet out of sight in the bathroom. It measures

 $7 \frac{1}{2}$ " by 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " tall without the lid. Techniques learned will be twining, twill and reverse twill, plus tension control in the weaving to create (reasonably!) straight walls.



All classes are suitable for beginners, or those with some experience. All basketry materials will be supplied by the instructor.
