AWCA Carving Calendar:

Alberta Wildlife Carving Association will be holding its weekly, Tuesday carving nights in the Industrial Arts Lab at Amiskwaciy Academy from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm on the following dates until year-end:

November - 5/12/19/26

December – 3/10

Our Christmas Party will be held on Tuesday, December 17, 2013, commencing at 6 pm at the Amiskwaciy Academy. The cost to members will be \$10.00/person, given to Kathleen Norton prior to the end of Tuesday night class of December 10th.

Regular classes at the Academy commence on Tuesday, January 7th in the New Year.

Improving your Carving Skills:

Carving is like golf, you need to play to improve! The AWCA provide courses on Tuesday nights from Oct to April, with two hours of teaching per night, commencing at 6 pm with a break for coffee in between, finishing at approx. 8:30 pm. This is equivalent to approx. 40 – 48 hrs. of course time over the 6-7 months, which is equal to a 5-6 Day class. **COST \$330.00 Options to Improve:**

- **Carve at home** or with a friend. The AWCA offers a large amount of reference material in our library, which includes cast, patterns and reference books. Talk to John Stevenson if you need something. If you know of some material that is not in our library, we can purchase it for your use and then add it to our system. **COST \$0.00**
- Take carving classes at other locations:
 - ➤ BOAG LAKE WOOD CARVING STUDIO located 1 mile East of Sherwood Park offer various classes for all skill levels. Check out the information on the AWCA website and posted on the bulletin board at Amiskwaciy. COST \$390.00-\$650.00. Currently Boag Lake is offering the following course during the upcoming year:

- > SASKATCHEWAN RIVER ART SCHOOL-SHEKINIAH on May 16-21, 2014. This is a five day artist retreat located north of Saskatoon offering classes in Carving, Painting and Photography. See the information on their website. COST \$650.00 + TRAVEL
- CARVING IN THE PARK sponsored by the AWCA. These workshops are being held July 8-13, 2014 in Sherwood Park at the Strathcona Arts Red Barn. Lana Cowel will be doing a female American Goldfinch, Byron Crabb will be doing a Mammal TBA, Beth Crabb will be doing baskets. COST \$490.00 - \$590.00
- ➤ SHUSWAP SCHOOL OF CARVING-in SORRENTO, B.C. on Sept 21-26, 2014. This five day carving school offer a variety of courses for carvers. Check their website for more information. COST \$650.00 + TRAVEL

There are also several other classes held throughout Canada and the US. The above costs are for members in the Edmonton area. Cost for Shekinah and Sorrento include accommodation and food, the local classes do not. The above information is an estimate only. Each artist needs to evaluate their goals and objective and enjoy carving to the fullest.

Images of Nature Show 2014:

Images of Nature Show will be held at the Sherwood Park Community League "Log Cabin" (50 Spruce Avenue Sherwood Park, Alberta) on Friday May 2rd to Sunday May 4th 2014. The Alberta Wildlife Carving Association will sponsor three purchase awards with additional community based purchase awards to be announced as they become available. AWCA 2014 Purchase Awards are as follows:

- \$1000.00 for the best life-size Songbird, M/F decorative or slick with suitable habitat.
- > \$750.00 for the best **North American Land Mammal**, decorative or slick with suitable habitat.
- \$500 for the best North American Shorebird, decorative or slick (gunning style on a stick acceptable)
- All entries must be wildlife, with no carvings of domesticated animals.
