



GLENN MABER FOUNDER'S AWARD

This award is designed to honour the legacy of Glenn Maber and celebrate AWCA members who display a long-term commitment to the Alberta Wildlife Carving Association and three-dimensional wildlife art.

The award serves as an inspiration for future members to uphold Glenn's legacy of volunteerism, mentorship, leadership and commitment to our art form.

To be eligible for this award, the following criteria must be met:

- Open to AWCA members who demonstrate dedication to the mission of the AWCA and three-dimensional wildlife art. Nominees should demonstrate several of the following traits:
 - A willingness to assist in club activities (volunteerism)
 - Commitment to mentorship and education in carving
 - Contributions to club governance
 - A commitment to improvement in their personal three-dimensional wildlife art journey.

The nomination process is held annually in November of each year. AWCA members are invited to nominate individuals by submitting a written nomination to the Board of Directors by January 1st annually.

A Selection Committee, created by the Board of Directors, reviews all nominations received and selects the recipient based on the criteria as noted above.

The *Glenn Maber Founder's Award* is presented on an annual basis, depending on the number of qualified nominees and is given at the AWCA's Annual BBQ held in conjunction with the Images of Nature Show. The recipient receives a personalized gift/plaque to keep and has their name placed on the *Glenn Maber Founder's Award* Plaque. They will also be recognized in the AWCA Newsletter and website.
